### **Discuss Important Issues With Your Legislators**

Increase Basic Education Funding The PA Principals Association joined the Fair Funding Campaign and support its recommendations for significant increases in basic education funding using the new school funding formula.

#### **Revision of Principal and Teacher Evaluations as Part of ESSA State Plan**

The PA Principals Association supports significant changes to Act 82 Educator Effectiveness. The current principal and teacher evaluation tools are ineffective and unfair. We must inform legislators that there must be significant revisions to Act 82 as a part of the ESSA plan that will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Education in 2017.

#### **Support Pre-K Education**

The PA Principals Association advocates for a \$60 million increase in state funding for pre-kindergarten programs in the 2017-18 budget. This would provide an additional 14,000 children with access to preschool.

### Address Pennsylvania's Pension Crisis

The PA Principals Association continues to support a defined benefit plan while also correcting the debt not caused by school employees. It is time for our legislators to finalize a solution that provides short-term relief while creating long-term stability.
