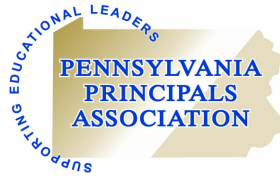

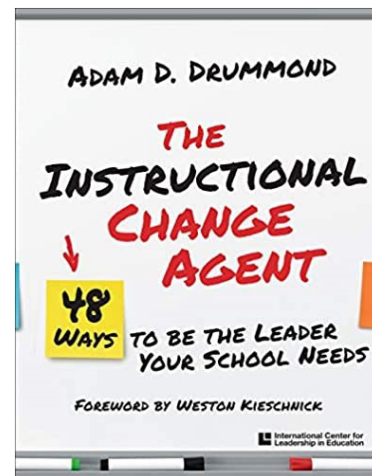

It's exhausting to be a school leader right now, and I bet you could use some **small wins**.

I chose to summarize Adam Drummond's book ***The Instructional Change Agent*** this month because he provides incredibly concrete strategies you can put into effect tomorrow (or better, in the fall when school re-opens;).

* 7 ways to impact **school culture** -- *For example, sending yourself on regular culture walkthroughs*

* 4 ways to build **connections with the community** -- *For example, convene a Community Advisory Team*

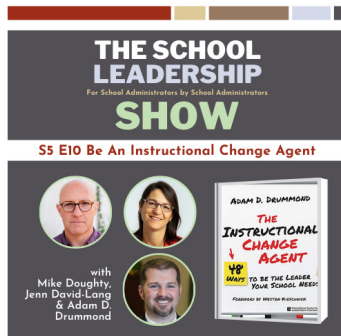
