The Summit

The annual Nobel Prize Teacher Summit is organized by the Nobel Prize Museum in Stockholm, Sweden.

Nobel Prize laureates and thought leaders from around the world participate as speakers for the event, and educators have the opportunity to learn alongside peers from over 25 countries.

The program includes a visit to a Swedish school in addition to short lectures, panel discussions, and peer group workshops based on a central theme affecting education systems around the world. This year, the summit will focus on the timely theme of democracy.
