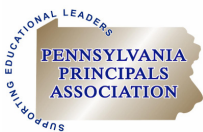

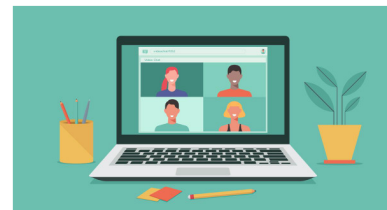

Senate Appropriations Committee – Budget Hearing with DOR - 02/18/25, 9:30 a.m., Hearing Room 1, North Office Building

The committee held a budget hearing with the Department of Revenue. The Department of Revenue (DOR) was represented by: Patrick Browne, secretary, DOR, Adria Zimmerman, deputy secretary for administration, DOR, Amy Gill, deputy secretary of tax policy, DOR, and Stephanie Weyant, deputy executive director of marketing and products, Pennsylvania Lottery.

Chairman Scott Martin (R-Lancaster) opened the 2025-2026 budget meeting for DOR, stating the state general fund budget request was \$231.7 million.
