PROGRAM PURPOSE:

Continually feeding an educator's desire for professional learning is fundamental to promoting student achievement and growing a teacher's instructional capacity (Cook, 2016). This central idea has been supported by many in the field in education from as early as Knowles in 1978 through those such as Swanson in 2016 and many other researchers in between.

This course aims at joining together the art of effective professional development, with personalized, relevant and meaningful learning, thus affecting student learning in the classroom. The instructors will address each individual standard, key concept and competency and provide opportunities for the participants to practice, reflect, and refine their skills. The end goal is to transfer back to the individual districts and buildings, where teachers and students will be greatly impacted by designing more effective professional development experiences for their school, district, or organization, that apply the various theories and tenets learned throughout the course and their research.
