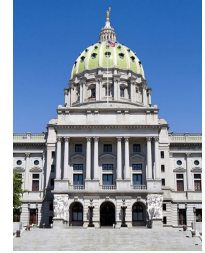

DCED: AVAILABILITY OF THE DRAFT 2024 CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AND EVALUATION REPORT

The Department of Community and Economic Development announced it is preparing its 2024 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) on the progress and accomplishments made during the 2024 program year in implementing the commonwealth's Consolidated Plan for federal fiscal years 2024-2028. This document must be submitted to, and approved by, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the commonwealth and organizations within the commonwealth to receive funding under most HUD housing and community development programs. The Consolidated Plan creates a unified strategy for housing, homelessness and community development programs, as well as the necessary linkages for building successful neighborhoods and communities.

Individuals or organizations may provide written comments regarding this draft version of CAPER. The report will be available on March 8, 2025, on the department's [website](#).
